SYNOPSIS OF LAWS ENACTED BY CHAPTER

Chapter 1 **DISPOSITION OF REMAINS OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES**
Gives a person the right to make the decisions about the disposition of the remains of a member of the state's organized militia, a state resident who is a member of the armed forces, or a state resident who is a member of the Coast Guard, if the member has authorized the person on a specified Department of Defense or Coast Guard form to direct the disposition and if the member has died while in a duty status.
(CSSB 33(STA))

Effective Date: June 9, 2011

Chapter 2 **TED STEVENS DAY**
Establishes the fourth Saturday of July each year as Ted Stevens Day.
(CSHB 101(STA))

Effective Date: July 21, 2011

Chapter 3 **EXTENDS THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE STATE COORDINATOR FOR NOXIOUS WEED, INVASIVE PLANT, AND AGRICULTURAL PEST MANAGEMENT AND EDUCATION**
Makes the position of state coordinator for noxious weed, invasive plant, and agricultural pest management and education in the Department of Natural Resources permanent. The coordinator position had been scheduled to terminate June 30, 2011.
(HB 97)

Effective Date: April 23, 2011

Chapter 4 **CORRECTION OF THE SPELLINGS OF "OXYMORPHONE" AND "LORAZEPAM"**
Corrects the spellings of "oxymorphone", a schedule IA controlled substance, and "lorazepam", a schedule IVA controlled substance. (HB 116 am)

Effective Date: April 23, 2011

Chapter 5 **DISPLAY, FOLDING, PRESENTMENT, AND RETIREMENT OF THE STATE FLAG**

Describes the proper way to display the state flag and details the procedure for folding, presenting, and retiring the state flag. (SCS HB 98(STA))

Effective Date: July 27, 2011

Chapter 6 **SENIOR BENEFITS AND LONG-TERM CARE ALLOWANCES**

Extends the sunset of the senior benefits to June 30, 2015. Increases the monthly personal needs allowance for a Medicaid recipient who is residing in a long-term care facility, and for a resident of an Alaska Pioneers' or Veterans' Home to \$200. (SCS HB 16(FIN))

Effective Date: July 31, 2011

Chapter 7 **ALASKA INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND EXPORT AUTHORITY (AIDEA), HOUSING FOR LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS, AND HARBOR FACILITY GRANTS**

Directs the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) to manage and operate housing for low-income households in the same manner as it formerly managed and operated low-cost housing projects, and authorizes AHFC to create subsidiaries that may acquire, develop, manage, or operate affordable housing. Authorizes regional housing authorities to apply for harbor facility grants, and allows municipalities or regional housing authorities to use money obtained from two additional sources as matching funds for harbor facility grants. Exempts AIDEA from the procurement code and authorizes it to adopt regulations governing procurement. Allows AIDEA to use money in its economic development account on a development project owned by a limited liability company in which AIDEA is a member or owns shares. (SCS CSHB 119(FIN))

Effective Date: May 7, 2011; AS 29.60.810(2)(D), added by section 6, is retroactive to January 1, 1993

Chapter 8 **CORRECTIVE AMENDMENTS: 2011 REVISOR'S BILL**

Makes corrective amendments to various Alaska Statutes as recommended by the revisor of statutes. (CSSB 61(STA))

Effective Date: May 10, 2011

Chapter 9 **SALARY OF THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF BOARD OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY**

Places the position of Executive Secretary of the Board of Public Accountancy in the

partially exempt service, and sets the secretary's monthly salary. (SB 90)

Effective Date: August 15, 2011

Chapter 10 COUNTING OF WRITE-IN VOTES

Requires the director of the Division of Elections to disregard any abbreviation, misspelling, or other minor variation in the form of the name of a write-in candidate if the intention of the voter can be ascertained. Provides when, where, and how write-in votes on a general election ballot will be counted for a candidate. (HCS CSSB 31(STA) am H)

Effective Date: August 15, 2011

Chapter 11 ADDING SUPERIOR COURT JUDGES

Adds two superior court judges in the third judicial district. (SB 58)

Effective Date: July 1, 2011

Chapter 12 PREVENTION AND EVALUATION OF CONCUSSIONS IN STUDENT ATHLETES

Requires public school district boards to develop and publish guidelines in consultation with the Alaska School Activities Association to educate coaches, athletes, and parents on the nature and risks of concussion. Minimum guidelines must include removal of athlete on suspicion of concussion, evaluation of athlete, and a written release for participation by a qualified person. Provides for limited immunity for school districts. (CSHB 15(JUD))

Effective Date: August 25, 2011

Chapter 13 LICENSING OF SPORT FISHING OPERATORS AND GUIDES

Extends the termination date of the licensing of sport fishing operators and sport fishing guides to January 1, 2013. (HB 173)

Effective Date: May 28, 2011

Chapter 14 BOARD OF EDUCATION REPORT AND THEME-BASED EDUCATION TASK FORCE

Requires the state Board of Education and Early Development to prepare and present an annual report to the legislature pertaining to policy decisions and efforts taken to improve education. Establishes a temporary joint legislative task force for the purpose of compiling data, including research on theme-based education, and

advising the legislature on public school curriculum. (HCS CSSB 1(RLS))

Effective Date: August 25, 2011

Chapter 15 **LIABILITY OF LIMITED LIABILITY LIQUOR LICENSE ORGANIZATIONS AND LIABILITY OF CERTAIN PERSONS DRIVING VEHICLES OF PERSONS UNDER THE INFLUENCE**

Clarifies that a partner of a limited liability partnership or a foreign limited liability partnership that holds a liquor license in the state is not relieved of the liability otherwise imposed upon the holder of a liquor license generally in the state. Provides that taxicab and limousine companies, their agents and employees, liquor licensees, and other persons are not liable for accidents that occur when a person employed by or under contract to a taxicab or limousine or related company is driving an intoxicated person's vehicle home from licensed premises under certain circumstances and provides certain exceptions to this nonliability. (CSSB 78(JUD))

Effective Date: August 25, 2011

Chapter 16 **ESTABLISHING ALASKA PUBLIC GARDENS DAY**

Establishes Alaska Public Gardens Day on the Saturday immediately preceding Memorial Day each year. (CSHB 18(STA) am)

Effective Date: August 25, 2011

Chapter 17 **WALTER L. KUBLEY KETCHIKAN FERRY TERMINAL**

Names the Ketchikan ferry terminal the Walter L. Kubley Ketchikan Ferry Terminal. (HB 214 am)

Effective Date: September 6, 2011

Chapter 18 **FRANK PALMER AUKE BAY FERRY TERMINAL**

Names the Auke Bay ferry terminal the Frank Palmer Auke Bay Ferry Terminal. (SB 95 am H)

Effective Date: September 6, 2011

Chapter 19 **SPC. STEPHEN "MAX" CAVANAUGH JR., MEMORIAL OVERPASS**

Names the Dowling Road overpass at milepost 123.7 on the New Seward Highway the Spc. Stephen "Max" Cavanaugh, Jr., Memorial Overpass. (SB 108)

Effective Date: September 6, 2011

Chapter 20 **CRIMINAL LAW AND PROCEDURE MATTERS**

Amends the definition of "nonconsensual contact" for purposes of stalking laws. Amends sexual assault in the third and fourth degrees by including sexual acts committed by a peace officer against a person in the custody of the peace officer or a law enforcement agency as violations of those offenses. Increases the felony classification of the crime of online enticement by one level. Provides that certain uses of keystroke loggers and similar devices and programs are a violation of the crime of criminal use of a computer. Provides that a person commits the crime of endangering the welfare of a child if the person knowingly leaves a child with a person required to register as a child kidnapper. Creates the crime of sending an explicit image of a minor if the person distributes certain explicit images of a minor under certain circumstances. Creates the crimes of misconduct involving confidential information in the first and second degrees committed when a person improperly obtains confidential information about another person under certain circumstances. Provides that jurisdiction is proper in this state for prosecutions of online enticement and sending an explicit image of a minor for certain conduct committed outside of this state. Provides that as a condition of probation, persons convicted of certain sexual offenses may be prohibited from residing within 500 feet of school grounds. Modifies and prescribes presumptive ranges of imprisonment for certain sexual offenses. Increases from 24 to 48 hours the period of time within which a person must be brought before a judge or magistrate after arrest. Provides that a person operating a motor vehicle without having the person's driver's license in the person's possession commits an infraction. Reduces the penalty for operating a motor vehicle without having proof of insurance in the person's possession from a misdemeanor to an infraction. Provides that the commissioner of the Department of Corrections may provide active supervision to a person on probation for a misdemeanor offense. Clarifies that the penalties for violation of regulations in the Knik River Public Use Area do not apply to certain arson offenses. Authorizes the attorney general to issue subpoenas for certain information relating to Internet service accounts when there is reasonable cause to believe that the account has been used in the sexual exploitation of children. Requires the Department of Law to submit a report to the legislature relating to the timing and number of arraignments provided within 24 and 48 hours after the arrest of a person. **(SCS CSHB 127(JUD))**

Effective Date: July 1, 2011

Chapter 21 **INCREASED PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN ALCOHOL OFFENSES COMMITTED BY SEX OFFENDERS OR CHILD KIDNAPPERS**

Provides for an increased penalty for a sex offender or child kidnapper who provides alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years, or allows a person under 21 years of age to possess alcoholic beverages, in violation of certain alcoholic beverages statutes. **(CSSB 15(JUD))**

Effective Date: September 21, 2011

Chapter 22 **CLASSIFYING CERTAIN SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS AS SCHEDULE IIIA CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES**

Classifies certain synthetic cannabinoids as Schedule IIIA controlled substances and provides penalties related to those substances. (SCS CSHB 7(JUD))

Effective Date: July 1, 2011

Chapter 23 **INSURANCE**

Chapter 24 **EXPANDING THE RANGE OF COMMUNITIES ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION IN CONSTRUCTING WATER AND SEWER FACILITIES UNDER THE VILLAGE SAFE WATER ACT**

Changes the definition of "village" for the purposes of the Village Safe Water Act to encompass a larger number of communities. (CSHB 183(FIN) am)

Effective Date: June 24, 2011

Chapter 25 **EXCEPTIONS TO LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY MEMBERS AND THEIR SPOUSES, AND TEMPORARY LICENSES FOR PAWNBROKERS**

Allows the spouse of a military member on active duty to obtain a courtesy license if licensed in another state or territory. Exempts a military member on hazardous duty from professional license renewal requirements. Allows pawnbrokers already in business on July 1, 2011, to apply for a temporary license good until December 31, 2011. (SCS CSHB 28(L&C))

Chapter 26 **CREATING ADDITIONAL NOTICE AND PUBLIC HEARING REQUIREMENTS FOR MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES THAT WOULD REQUIRE THAT A SPRINKLER SYSTEM BE INCLUDED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS**

Establishes additional notice and public hearing requirements for a municipality that seeks to adopt an ordinance requiring a sprinkler system to be included in the construction of new single-family residential buildings, residential buildings with not more than two dwelling units, or both types of buildings. **(CSHB 130(L&C))**

Effective Date: October 11, 2011

Chapter 27 **ANTITRUST CIVIL AND CRIMINAL PENALTIES**

Increases the criminal penalty for certain antitrust violations to a class C felony. Increases the possible fines for these criminal violations and allows for imprisonment as provided by the general criminal sentencing provisions. Allows the attorney general to bring a civil action against a person who violates certain listed antitrust provisions or certain injunctions. Sets the ranges for the amounts that may be imposed as civil penalties against natural persons and against persons who are not natural persons. **(CSHB 87(L&C))**

Chapter 28 **PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS**

Limits the application of the requirement to pay the prevailing current rate of wages to public construction contracts that exceed \$25,000. These requirements cover the advertised specifications, contractual provisions, employee wage schedule filings, notices of work begun, notices of completion, payment withholding by a contracting agency, penalties for violations, remedies for violations, and distribution of lists of noncomplying contractors. **(CSHB 155(L&C))**

Chapter 29 **INTEREST RATES**

Changes the maximum interest rate that parties may expressly agree to in a contract or a loan commitment. Sets the maximum rate at the greater of 10 percent or five percentage points above a specified Federal Reserve District rate. Applies if the principal amount exceeds \$25,000. **(HB 188)**

Chapter 30 **MARK HUFFORD TRAIL**

Names the pathway parallel to the section of Eagle River Loop Road connecting Old Glenn Highway with North Parkview Terrace Loop the Mark Hufford Trail. **(HB 213)**

Chapter 31 **SOUTHEAST STATE FOREST**

Increased the amount of land in the Southeast State Forest. **(HB 105)**

Effective Date: September 8, 2011

Chapter 32 **FEES FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT AND SERVICES UNDER WORKERS' COMPENSATION**

For treatment and services provided after December 10, 2010, modifies one of three methods of determining the fee or charge paid for medical treatment or service. The usual, customary and reasonable fee for treatment or service may not exceed the fee or charge specified in a fee schedule established by the board and adopted by regulation based on statistically credible data. The data must include charges based on the charges for certain medical services maintained by the American Medical Association and the Health Care Procedure Coding System, must reflect the costs in the geographical area where services are provided, and must result in a schedule that is at the 90th percentile. **(HB 13)**

Increases the number of directors of the Alaska Energy Authority needed for a quorum to four. Amends the powers of the Authority by including the ability to obtain necessary permits, licenses, or approvals to construct or acquire projects. Amends the powers of the Authority by allowing the Authority to acquire a Susitna River power project and perform feasibility studies and engineering and design with respect to power projects. Requires the Authority to prepare an annual report summarizing the status of the Susitna River power project. Provides that a project acquired or constructed under AS 44.83.080(18) is owned and shall be administered by the Authority. Provides legislative approval for loans by the Authority from the power project fund for a Reynolds Creek hydroelectric project and a Humpback Creek hydroelectric project. **(CSSB 42(FIN))**
