The **Legislative Teleconference Network** allows small groups to interact via a dedicated circuit that functions like a huge telephone party line. Participation in legislative committee hearings and informal meetings between constituent groups and legislators is possible from regional information facilities and several sites in Washington, D.C.

Regional **Legislative Information Offices** are equipped to provide current information on legislative activity. During legislative sessions, reports of floor and committee activity are transmitted to the Information Offices immediately after daily floor sessions adjourn. Printed materials are usually available on a one-day delay basis. Data communications equipment provides access to a computerized bill-tracking system and speeds transmission of business messages between legislators and their constituents.
