## Heads Up!

### Campaign Website - 2014 Legislative Session

Important Information! ALL VERBIAGE AND VISUALS REFERENCING "SOLICITING" CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS MUST BE REMOVED FROM CAMPAIGN WEBSITES DURING A LEGISLATIVE SESSION.



You may state, "Campaign contributions cannot be accepted during a legislative session".



However, you may not include a statement similar to, "Check back after session for information on how to donate".

AS 24.60.031(b) A legislator may not request or accept a contribution, or a promise, or pledge to make a contribution, for the legislator's own campaign for state or municipal office. while the legislature is in regular or special session.

## **Additional Session Fundraising Restrictions**

Legislator

A legislator may not solicit or accept a contribution or a promise or pledge to make a contribution:

- for another candidate in an election for municipal, state or federal office;
- to influence a state ballot proposition or question; or for a political party

**Legislative Employee** 

Only restricted to state or municipal candidates.
